## **Solid Waste Management**

Kalburgi Cement Private limited in association with association with CHF India Foundation has initiated a operation of community waste management in alignment with Indian Government's clean and green cities, towns and villages. The objective of this project is to make our villages clean and green.



A part of inorganic waste generated in these villages will form input in the process of cement manufacturing for firing the Kiln as Alternate Fuel and Raw Material (AFR) as an initiative to save nonrenewable energy resources. Organic waste is beina subjected vermicomposting resulting in availability of manure for backyard kitchen gardens.

The objective of project is to make the adopted villages zero waste, which would result in clean and healthy environs enabling the community to contribute better to the society. The objective of the project is to make these villages clean and green with an overall perspective of health well-being of the community. The project is being implemented in two village **Chatrasala and Kherchkhed**.

**330.62** tons of waste is recycled since project incepted in 2018 till December 2021.







### Safe drinking water


**03** Reverse osmosis safe drinking water plants were set-up in the 3 villages Chincholi taluka of Kalaburgi District to ensure safe drinking water for the villagers of neighborhood. These RO Plants are handled by Naandi Foundation, which delivers safe and clean drinking water across the country. The objective of the whole program is to orient the villagers towards safe and clean drinking water sessions conducted periodically.

Our implementing partner conducts intensive campaigns to increase the awareness among the people and build & instill the sense of ownership within the community on safe drinking water. Further, community connect programs are held in schools and colonies to enlighten the people on safe drinking water and on hand wash.










# **Quality Education for Future Generation.**

**20 kids** from Government Primary School, Chatrasala are provided free education in the School.



A primary health center is functioning at Chatrasala village with a dedicated doctor attending to the community's health issues. On an average, 25-30 patients visit the health center every day. Total 9309 consultations took

place between (January December) 2021. This

Health center is operated for 4 hours daily. People from the surrounding plant periphery access the health camp facility.





# **Cement Concrete roads in Kherchkhed village**

500 meters of cement road connectivity was established in the Kherchkhed village. Bye lanes in the village were cemented as these roads get inundated during monsoon. The roads have reduced the water logging & mosquito breedi breeding in the village.





## **COVID -19 support**

- 1. Supported by contributing 25 oxygen concentrators for surrounding hospitals in the plant area worth Rs. 25 lacs
- 2. Supported Government hospital, Chincholi by providing material for COVID-19 ward encompassing beds, electrical fixtures, air-conditioners etc., We have also done civil work in the ward. The entire support is to the tune of Rs.20 lacs.
